- d. Operational Change for ESD 16
 - i. Access to radio room requires several requirements:
 - 1. Understanding of operational Procedure for ESD16 Radio Antenna usage, parameters
 - 2. personal vetting
 - 3. background checks by ESD
 - 4. radio usage (General Class)
 - 5. limitations (coffee is off-limits)
 - ii. In the ESD meeting last month, ESD approved an agreement with the club that lays out the conditions that the members can use the amateur radio equipment (in the dispatch room)
 - 1. All individuals required to have a background check initiated by the Fire Department
 - a. ESD 16 will send an email to each individual with a link to submit a background check document. We will receive yes or no as a result of the background check.
 - 2. A background check for each county costs \$40, but ESD 16 should not charge NARS for these background checks
 - 3. When you are approved, you will receive a key fob to certain doors in the ESD-16 Admin building so you can get access to the radio room.
 - 4. Access logs will be tied to key fob to track activities are the building
 - 5. NARS board needs to come up with basic guidelines to understand how to manage this
 - a. Rich Jones and Paul Owen will put together a committee to draw up these guidelines
